2.1 Standing Committee on Standards and Processes

2.1.1 IVOA DOCS STANDARD 1.2

Many comments on 1.1 in RFC bringing quite some updates. Including new document numbering nomenclature.

During the last RFC, there were significant comments so the document went back in WD. Now the RFC has been re-initiated today on 12/05 up to 11/06.

2.2 APPS

SAMP became a REC in April 2009.

SAMP is being quite well adopted and there will be a dedicated session on SAMP applications at Strasbourg interop.

Continuous efforts to have APPs WG collaboration with other WGs. There will be a Apps/GWS session in Strasbourg.

2.3 DAL

2.3.1 SIAP 1.0

Inputs from last Interop in Baltimore:

SIAv1 legacy version updated. Ready to start review SIAv1 legacy version updated. Ready to start review process to produce a fast recommendation process.

Ray reminded everybody that many SIAP 1.0 services have been existing for a long time and therefore only minor comments should be accepted as this standard is mainly for legacy purposes and SIAP 2.0 will come later.

2.3.2 SLAP

- * Discuss and reach agreement on TAP V1.0 points
- * Publish TAP V0.5 before Strasbourg
- * Discuss details in Strasbourg
- * Move TAP forwards in the standards process very soon after the Interop with the aim of getting a recommended standard in the weeks following the meeting

2.3.4 SIAP 2.0

Inputs from last Interop in Baltimore:

Francois Bonnarel is preparing 1st WD of SIAP 2.0 and will present it at the next interop. It would be useful to have the WD distributed to the WG prior to the interop.

2.4 DM

Inputs from last Interop in Baltimore:

2.5.2 CREDENTIAL DELEGATION

Significant formatting of the document is required and should be sent prior to interop. There is no functional changes in the standard.

We agree that these changes do NOT require the document to go back to WG and that it will then go into the TCG review.

2.5.3 VOSI 1.01

Inputs from last Interop in Baltimore:

Consistent with VODataService and TAP. To go to PR together

No work done on that since Baltimore interop. Will be discussed at GWS session which takes place after the DAL/TAP session.

2.5.4 BP (BASIC PROFILE)

Inputs from last Interop in Baltimore:

Dependent on VOSI. Go to PR end of 2008?

Need to wait for VOSI first. No change then.

2.5.5 UWS (PR START 01/08)

Inputs from last TCG teleconf in September 2008:

Similarly to VOSI, Activities have been delayed a bit, also waiting for experience gained in other standards, in particular TAP. The plan is now to have some discussion and agreement at Baltimore and then start the RFC process.

Pending on TAP. Will be discussed at GWS session which takes place after the DAL/TAP session.

2.6 Registry

2.6.1 REGISTRY INTERFACE

RFC ended in November 2008:

One of the major concern expressed during RFC was the fact that Registry Interface uses ADQL 1.0 although this later which never went to REC. The formal IVOA Recommendation is ADQL 2.0 which has significant changes from ADQL 1.0. But all existing IVOA Registries already use ADQL 1.0 and it would not make sense at this stage to change Registry Interface specs to use ADQL 2.0 as this would make ALL IVOA Registries uncompliant.

Therefore, we agreed that Registry Interface should include ADQL 1.0 as an appendix to the Interface so the standard is full self standing and can follow the recommendation process. A new version of the Registry Interface will be issued anyway.

2.6.2 VODATASERVICE

Inputs from last Interop in Baltimore:

Collaboration with TAP and GWS

Revision based on the recent progress on TAP, addressing the comments received.

TAP table metadata issues seem to be fairly agreed. That should allow VODataservice to go forward, which then should allow VOSI to go forward.

WD issued on 08/05 and should be distributed to the WG

We should wait to have the discussion and agreement on TAP at Strasbourg interop and see if that affects or not VODATASERVICE and then go to RFC after interop.

2.6.3 VOSTANDARD

WD should be put together by Strasbourg interop and discussion will take place there. RFC could start a couple of week after interop.

2.6.4 VOAPPLICATIONS

WD should be put together by Strasbourg interop and discussion will take place there.

2.6.5 SIA/SCS EXTENDED RESOURCE

WD should be put together by Strasbourg interop and discussion will take place there.

2.6.6 REGISTRY CURATION TOOLS

There will be a dedicated Registry session on Curation tools.

2.7 Semantics

2.7.1 VO-VOCABULARIES

RFC and TCG Review ended

2.7.2 UCD 1+

Inputs from last TCG teleconf in September:

These consist only of new words, there is no change to the existing UCDs.

The UCD 1+ WD 1.0 will be issued on 04/09.

Sebastien will distribute a document before the interop and it will be discussed during a session at the next interop.

2.8 VOQL

Not many activities since last interop, pending implementations of ADQL and TAP being released. The VOQL session at Strasbourg interop will only have a couple of presentations.

2.9 VOTable

2.9.1 VOTABLE 1.2

Inputs from Baltimore interop:

VOTable1.2: agreement to move to Recommendation procedure; slightly modified version will be submitted for RFC

There will be an other VOTable session at Strasbourg interop.

A new WD should then be issue and then RFC to start soon after Strasbourg.

2.10 VOEvent

Most of the WG have attended an other HOTwire workshop instead of the interop where these things were discussed. Rob gave some feedback on this successful meeting.

There will not be dedicated VOEvent session

Next VOEvent activity will be at the AAS meeting with 2 days session on robotic telescopes.

2.10.1 VOEVENT 2.0

Inputs from last TCG teleconf in September:

VOEvent 2.0 is now working towards a schedule to go to PR mid January 2009. VOEvent 1.1 is being well used. VOEvent 2.0 should extend on time series with a WD over summer.

2.10.2 SEAP SIMPLE EVENT ACCESS PROTOCOL

Inputs from Baltimore interop:

Internal WD

An updated WD needs to be issued following recent discussions since Baltimore.

Some discussion took place about the VOEvent activities. It is recognized that VOEvent community is very active, especially outside the IVOA with various meetings, conferences and workshops where VOEvent standards are discussed. Nonetheless, it was stated that it is important that these activities also take place in the context of the IVOA, according to IVOA structure. In particular, if a SEAP is to be developed, proper coordination should take place with the IVOA DAL WG.

2.10.3 REGISTRY EXTENSIONS

Inputs from Baltimore interop:

Registry extension to allow registration of VOEvent services and science streams.

Some presentation made at Baltimore, but no real progress since then.

Also waiting for the VODataServices is out.

2.11 Theory IG

2.11.1 SIMDB

Inputs from Baltimore interop:

Complete the SimDB design and the Note

Some delay in writing the document, testing prototypes.

The document may be split into two, one going for the DM WG. This will probably come after Strasbourg interop, sometimes before the summer.
