Why ?

- XML Web Services are now becoming standards
 - Web : distributing programming library modules as well as web pages
- Several participants to the IVOA are developing this kind of service
- It is now time to show how to consume these Web Services



Goal

- The main goal of this tutorial is to give answers to the following questions:
 - How to consume a Web Service ?
 - How to build a Web Service?, how does it work on the server side?
- This tutorial is not a lecture about SOAP, WSDL, ... but we can start with a quick reminder



Basics

- SOAP, Simple Object Access Protocol
 - XML based
 - The dialog format between a Client and a Web Service
- WSDL, Web Service Description Language
 - XML based
 - The recipe which contains information to implement a client (remember CORBA OMG-IDL)
- Notice: SOAP and WSDL are manipulated with tools, it is not mandatory to learn this two formats...
